This has to be a third batch of tanks because:

- 1. The first batch of tank were still operating with 154th Bde, 4th Div north of Aleppo during February. (this can be worked out from matching tank markings)
- 2. The 3rd batch of tanks are on a different type low loaders than the 2nd batch
- 3. It is very unlikely that the 2nd batch of tanks were moved up to Aleppo and then moved all the way back down to Homs,


